

Terms of Reference - Student Academic Experience Committee

Section 1 - Purpose

- (1) The Student Academic Experience Committee is a subcommittee of Academic Board. It is the principal advisory committee of the Academic Board on issues relating to the student academic experience. The Committee will:
 - a. Develop, monitor, review and advise the Academic Board on University Rules, Policies, Procedures and Guidelines relating to:
 - i. supporting successful transition to study including orientation and early assessment;
 - ii. academic and other student support services;
 - iii. student representation and voice;
 - iv. recognition of academic achievements.
 - b. Monitor and report on:
 - i. the effectiveness of, and student engagement with, student academic support services including transition to study services;
 - ii. student retention:
 - iii. students at risk and their engagement with student academic support services; and
 - iv. participation, progress and completion by identified student subgroups in the context of student support services.
 - c. Advise on general and specific initiatives undertaken to improve student engagement and experience.
 - d. Consider and report on any matters referred to by the Vice-Chancellor, Academic Board or the Chair, Academic Board.
 - e. Make a standing report to Academic Board at each ordinary meeting.

Section 2 - Composition

- (2) The membership of the Student Academic Experience Committee is:
 - a. Ex officio members
 - i. Chair: Deputy Chair (Students), Academic Board
 - ii. Vice President (Students) and Registrar (or nominee)
 - iii. Dean, Graduate School (or nominee)
 - iv. Executive Director, Global (or nominee)
 - v. Director, Centre for Teaching and Learning (or nominee)
 - vi. Dean, Gnibi College of Indigenous Australian Peoples (or nominee)
 - vii. Director, Business Intelligence and Quality (or nominee)
 - b. Appointed members
 - i. One Associate Dean (Education) appointed by the Chair

- ii. One student from each of the University's Faculties and Colleges (with at least one being a higher degree research student) appointed by the Chair.
- (3) The Director, Student Support and Success (or nominee) will be an attendee at all meetings of the Student Academic Experience Committee.

Section 3 - Meetings

(4) Meetings and other business will be conducted in accordance with the <u>Standing Orders - Academic Board and its Committees</u>.
